2021-2022 ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL LOGISTICS

- EXPANDED EARLY ARRIVAL/CURBSIDE DROP OFF HOURS: **7:15 AM-8:20 AM**
- **Breakfast Hours:** 7:30 am- 8:20 am
- **Main Office Hours:** 8:00 a.m.- 4:00 p.m.
- Students arriving between 7:15-8:05 in grades K-2 will report to the cafeteria where they will be socially distanced and supervised by staff. Teachers will pick up K-2 students from the cafeteria at 8:05 AM. Students arriving via curbside after 8:05 will be escorted to class or the cafeteria if they would like breakfast. Students still eating breakfast after teachers pick up will be escorted to class.
- Students arriving between 7:15-8:20 in grades 3-5 will report to the cafeteria ONLY if they are eating breakfast. For 3rd-5th grade students not eating breakfast, they will report directly outside of the classroom where they will be supervised until the teacher receives them at 8:10 a.m.
- PRE-K students must be dropped off at the front gate on GRAND AVENUE. The teachers will receive the PREK students from the front gate on GRAND AVENUE at 8:05 a.m. Student arriving after 8:05 am will be escorted to class by student ambassadors.
STUDENTS WILL ENGAGE IN TEACHER DIRECTED EARLY ARRIVAL TASKS FROM THE TIME THEY ARE RECEIVED BY THE TEACHER UNTIL THE INSTRUCTIONAL DAY STARTS.

➤ Arrival Information

- **Parent Drop-Off (Arrival):** Parents will enter off of GRAND AVENUE onto Lincoln Boulevard. Make an immediate right on to WASHINGTON DRIVE. Follow the circular pathway. Make a LEFT on to JEFFERSON DRIVE and proceed to enter the TEACHER'S PARKING LOT AT CARVER ELEMENTARY.
- TRUE WALKERS will enter through the front gate on GRAND AVENUE and proceed to their arrival location.

➤ Dismissal Information

- Barnyard and Armbrister afterschool students in 2nd-5th will walk through the front gate on GRAND AVENUE to their respective afterschool programs. Students in K-1st will be picked up by representatives from these programs.
- TRUE WALKERS in grades 2nd-5th grade will exit the front gate on GRAND AVENUE and WALK to their homes.
- YMCA will pick up PREK-1ST grade participants. 2nd-5th Grade students participating in the YMCA will be escorted to the YMCA by a designated teacher in each grade level.
- **Parent Pick-Up (Dismissal):** Parents in grades K-3 will enter off of GRAND AVENUE onto Lincoln Boulevard. Make an immediate right on to WASHINGTON DRIVE. Follow the circular pathway. Make a LEFT on to JEFFERSON DRIVE and proceed to enter the TEACHER'S PARKING LOT AT CARVER ELEMENTARY. Parents with students in grades 4TH-5TH will enter off of GRAND AVENUE onto JEFFERSON STREET (across from the Miami Fire Department-Fire College).
- **Siblings will be provided sibling tags and dismissed together. Those families will be contacted by the classroom teacher with the specific pick up location and time.**

 - ❖ 4th-5th Grade: 3:05 pm

GENTLE REMINDERS 😊

- ❖ Please be respectful of the residential community and refrain from parking and blocking residential driveways.
- ❖ Please enter the car line at your child's staggered dismissal time. Not before please.'
- ❖ Please have your legibly written car tags hanging on your mirror for easy viewing.
- ❖ Please do not drop off students by the disposal bins near the cafeteria.
- ❖ Students must be READY to exit the vehicle at the gate in the middle of the parking lot in front of the tent. READY to immediately exit the vehicle.
- ❖ Please do not park or walk through the parking lot. It is a drive thru service only.
- ❖ Please assist us with an expeditious flow of cars by refraining from engaging in lengthy conversation.
- ❖ Please do not stop vehicles on Grand Avenue and load or unload children. For late arrivals, you MUST legally park your vehicle and accompany the child into the school building to be signed in. A valid photo identification will be required. Students will not be allowed to enter the front gate alone.
- ❖ Please follow all city, county and school parking signs/rules. All vehicles towed would be at the owners' expense.
