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Reading Summer Assignment for Incoming First Graders 2024-2025

Maintaining reading momentum over the summer break is crucial to warding off any learning gaps. With this in mind, we enthusiastically encourage our incoming first graders to explore a variety of genres for pleasure during their summer break. While we understand the value of freedom in summer activities, we've curated a single reading selection accompanied by a follow-up activity. This assignment should be submitted to their Reading teacher on the first day of school. Please find the specifics of the summer reading assignment outlined below.

Students should read the following selection:

Title: *Keep a Poem in Your Pocket* **Author:** Beatrice Schenk de Regniers

After reading the selection, students will create a poem. The poem should be at least four verses long. Students will “keep the poem in their pocket” on the morning of the first day of school and be ready to exchange poems with their classmates. An illustration matching the poem should be included. Students will be encouraged to recite the poem, but it is not required. Poems must be age appropriate.
