



## Fifth Grade Supply List & Summer Learning Assignments 2024-2025

**Learning materials** are grouped by subject. **Classroom items** such as wipes, tissue paper, etc. are provided to the HR teacher only. Each student must come prepared on the first day of school with a pencil pouch filled with 5 pre-sharpened pencils. (No mechanical pencils please!)

### **Reading & Writing**

- o 2 reams of white copy paper (letter size)
- o Student daily agenda/Planner
- o 4 Wide Ruled composition notebooks (light colored, non-labeled, no spiral notebooks)  
Please provide the labels if the composition notebook does not have a designated space for labeling.
- o HW Binder for all Subjects and Forms: One 1½ inch binder with pockets. (Must have clear view pocket on the front & back)
- o 1 pack of 5 pocket dividers with tabs (optional)
- o 1 pack of wide ruled paper
- o 1 box of crayons, color pencils, or twistable crayons (24 count)
- o 1 pack of Pens (not black ink)
- o 2 boxes of #2 sharpened pencils
- o 1 Black Sharpie (Fine print)
- o 1 pack of Expo dry-erase markers -thick tip
- o 1 pencil sharpener with a lid
- o 4 packs of glue sticks
- o 1 Yellow highlighter
- o 2 Petal Highlighters (multiple colors in one)
- o 1 pair of safety scissors (blunt tip)
- o 1 pack of Post-It notes (pastel colors only)
- o Zippered pencil pouch (no boxes)
- o 1 personal refillable water bottle to be always kept with student
- o Small umbrella (to fit inside of backpack)
- o Headphones or ear buds \*MANDATORY\* (To be kept in a Ziploc bag labeled with student's name)
- o 1 plastic duo-tang folder with 3 prongs and pockets



### Summer Math Assignment for Incoming 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Students



Students are REQUIRED to achieve 100% fact fluency in multiplication and division on Reflex Math upon entering 5th grade. Data has proven that students who are proficient with basic facts are scoring higher and growing faster than their peers. Reflex Math is the resource that M-DCPS and George W. Carver Elementary School utilizes to master their basic math facts as a prerequisite upon entering their grade level. **This mandatory assignment will be counted as a grade on the first quarter** based on the following grading scale:

- 90% - 100% Fact Fluency – A
- 80% - 89% Fact Fluency – B
- 70% - 79% Fact Fluency – C
- 60% - 69% Fact Fluency – D
- 0% - 59% Fact Fluency – F

Students transitioning from private and/or charter schools, without previous access to Reflex Math, will be assessed on their math fact fluency during the **first quarter of school**. Please plan to ensure that your child is prepared. [www.ReflexMath.com](http://www.ReflexMath.com)
