1. Summer Reading Book

AR Level: 1.4 | **Points:** 0.5

This playful story encourages children to embrace what makes them special. Students will take their first Accelerated Reader (AR) quiz on this book during the first quarter of school.

Poem: Keep a Poem in Your Pocket by Beatrice Schenk de Regniers

Assignment Instructions:

- After reading the poem, your child will write their own original poem (at least 4 lines long).

- Bring the poem in their pocket on the first day of school to share and exchange with classmates.

Reciting the poem is encouraged but not required. Please ensure poems are age-appropriate and showcase your child's creativity.
