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Summer Learning Incoming 2nd Grade Students



To help kick off the school year with connection and fun, each incoming second-grade student is invited to complete a special summer assignment: the "**All About Me Bag.**" This activity encourages students to reflect on their unique identities and share their stories with classmates, fostering a strong sense of classroom community from day one.

1. "All About Me Bag" Activity Instructions:

- Fill a bag with 4–5 small items that represent who your child is and what they love.
- Items should fit inside the bag and may include:
 - Something in your child's favorite color
 - o An award or certificate
 - o A small item representing a favorite sport, animal, or hobby
 - A favorite book or toy
 - A souvenir or item from a trip or special experience
- Write a short paragraph using complete sentences explaining the items in the bag and why they were chosen.
- Bring the bag and paragraph on the first day of school to share with classmates.

Even our teachers will be bringing their own "All About Me Bag" to share!

2. Summer Reading Selection

To complement the "All About Me Bag" activity and reinforce themes of self-identity and belonging, we have selected the following book for summer reading:

Book Title: What If You Had Animal Ears? by Sandra Markle

This engaging nonfiction book invites readers to imagine what it would be like to have different animal ears, blending fun facts with imaginative scenarios. It encourages children to appreciate their own unique features and sparks conversations about self-identity.

Assignment:

- **Read the book** over the summer & prepare to take **Accelerated Reader (AR) quiz** on this book during the first quarter of school.
- Parents can help check for understanding by discuss how the different animal traits compare to human traits and what makes each person unique.
