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Summer Reading Assignment for Incoming 4th Grade Students



Continuing to read over the summer is crucial for our students as it helps maintain their reading skills and prevents the "summer slide," ensuring they are ready for the challenges of the new school year. Encouraging daily reading fosters a lifelong love of learning and keeps their minds engaged and curious during the break. Incoming fourth grade students will be reading 2 books over the summer (**ONE** non-fiction and **ONE** fiction book from the list below).

After reading your books, select a character from **each** book you are most like. Write a three-paragraph essay explaining why you are similar to this character and providing examples, as well as text evidence where necessary. For example, have you been in a similar situation as the character in one of the books? Do you have the same ideas or feelings as this character? This will be taken as a Writing/Language Arts Grade during the first quarter.

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Summer Math Assignment for Incoming 4th Grade Students



Students are **REQUIRED** to achieve 100% fact fluency in multiplication and division on Reflex Math upon entering 4th grade. Data has proven that students who are proficient with basic facts are scoring higher and growing faster than their peers. Reflex Math is the resource that M-DCPS and George W. Carver Elementary School utilizes to master their basic math facts as a prerequisite upon entering their grade level. **This mandatory assignment will be counted as a grade on the first quarter** based on the following grading scale:

- 90% - 100% Fact Fluency – A
- 80% - 89% Fact Fluency – B
- 70% - 79% Fact Fluency – C
- 60% - 69% Fact Fluency – D
- 0% - 59% Fact Fluency – F

Students transitioning from private and/or charter schools, without previous access to Reflex Math, will be assessed on their math fact fluency during the **first quarter of school**. Please plan to ensure that your child is prepared. www.ReflexMath.com
