- O 1 bookbag (NO WHEELS)
- O 4 Primary composition books-Labeled with your child's first and last name
- O 10 large glue stick packs

- O 2 boxes of **sharpened** #2 pencils (no designs)
- O 4 boxes of crayons (24 count)
- O 1 pair of scissors (blunt tip)
